Class description:

Orange Ball

This program is for those juniors aged 7 - 10 years old who had some instruction and play. This class involves athletic movements, skill development, hand-eye coordination, more advanced stroke technique, tactics and starting to construct points. Players should be able to control at least a 21'' - 23'' racket.

Green/Yellow Ball Level 1

Green/Yellow Ball clinics are for players who want to continue to improve, or older players wanting to learn more about the game. This class focus on the contact point, proper technique, and shot consistency. Players should be able to control at least a 25" racket and make clean contact with the ball.

M.S/H.S. Prep 1

Is designed for those students who are wanting to play on their middle school or high school teams. Students will focus on consistency, basics of serving, groundstrokes, volleys & point play. Players should be able to move to and return a yellow (real) ball and use basic groundstroke technique.

<u>H.S. Prep 2</u>

Is designed for those students who are already playing on their High School teams who are wanting to improve their games for the next season. It focuses on proper consistency during point play, singles & doubles tactics and serving. Players should be able to serve with consistency, rally with a yellow (real) ball, keep score and are comfortable competing.

Performance class

For players actively playing competitive tennis who wish to take their games to the next level through hard work, high-intensity drills, and tournament play. It focuses on using proper technique to create heavy groundstrokes, proper footwork for different situations, the development of all-court skills (slice, volleys, overhead), commanding different spins on the serve, and singles & doubles point play. Also determining a specific style of play for each player and the development of multiple "weapons."

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
